Ohio Council of Community Schools (OCCS) uses various methods to evaluate the school's performance including published tests and other academic scores such as the Ohio Department of Education Local Report Card and supporting data. OCCS regional representatives visit our partner schools regularly ensuring compliance with federal, state, and contractual requirements. 2016-2017 Performance and Accountability Goals:

During the 2016-2017 school year, University of Cleveland Preparatory worked towards the completion of many goals. The school exceeded the local district by one full letter grade on the Progress Component Grade on the report card. The school also exceeded the district by one full letter grade in both the Value-Added measures for Students with Disabilities and for the students in the Lowest 20% of Achievement. For the measure of PI and AMO, University of Cleveland Preparatory outperformed 3 of 5 comparison schools. The school continues to work towards the achievement of their goals in the 2017-2018 school year.



2016-2017 State Report Card Report:

University of Cleveland Preparatory School is provided with a measure for its Progress, which looks closely at the growth that all students are making based on their past performances. University of Cleveland Preparatory was able to achieve a full letter grade above the local school district in this component. From the 2015-2016 school year to the 2016-2017 school year, University of Cleveland Preparatory was able to increase one full letter grade for its K-3 Literacy Component and also experienced increases in both its AMO and PI scores. The majority of the comparison schools scored similarly on the K-3 Literacy Component as well.
