Describe the use of funds:

In accordance with Ohio law, at least 50% of Student Wellness and Success Funds will be spent on physical or mental health services by contracting with outside agencies to provide counseling and other services to our students and hiring mental health professionals. University of Cleveland Preparatory School will use Student Wellness and Success Funds to provide psychological services, occupational therapy, physical therapy, and other services associated with supporting our student population.

Name and describe coordination with community partners:

Recent updates to Ohio laws aim to ensure districts and schools prioritize physical and mental health needs of students through strategic community partnerships. The University of Cleveland Preparatory School has developed partnerships with PSI Solutions, Total Education Solutions, Mindscapes, ProCare Therapy, and Serenity Health. The partnerships will include Psychology Services, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy, and wrap-around services.

Describe the anticipated impact of the utilization of funds:

Due to the allocation of the funds, 149 students at University of Cleveland Preparatory School will be impacted by the services. Our objective is to provide services for students including prevention programming, classroom support, group services, and individualized services, which will improve individual mental and behavioral health as well as overall school culture. With the service provided from Student Wellness and Success Funds, University of Cleveland Preparatory School will see a 15% decrease in disruptive student behavior by May of 2025.
